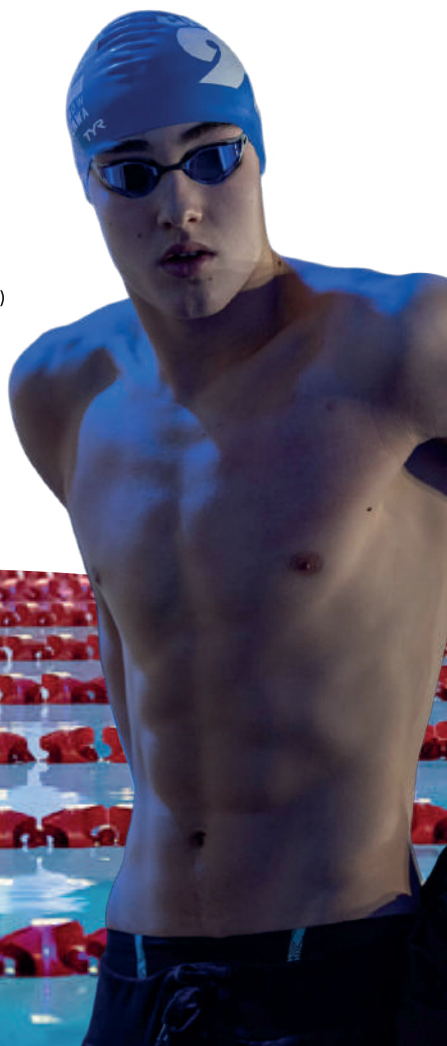

# Important Information

## 1. DATE AND PLACE

Competition will take place on 6-7.11.2026 at Orbita swimming pool near Wejherowska Str. 34 in Wrocław (POLAND).

Competition pool: short course 25 m, 10 lanes, water temp. 27 °C. Warm-up before competition will be available in all swimming pools. During prelims, warm-up will be available in two pools: warm-up pool 1 (25 m, 10 lanes, 27 °C) and warm-up pool 2 (25 m, 4 lanes, 28°C).

Maximum of 700 competitors will be admitted to the competition. Organizers will select swimmers with the best results according to the World Aquatics score in the SC pool. In exceptional cases, ensuring a high level, the organizer reserves the right to approve athletes who do not have a result in the ranking. Based on the results, the competitors will be divided into two heat groups.
